In 2021, we stood by our commitment to quality.

As one of the only nonprofits committed exclusively to serving kids with limb disabilities in the developing world, we are on a mission to reach the *greatest* number of children with the *highest* quality of care. Thanks to our years on the ground, we do so at the most cost-effective manufacturing rates — helping us serve more kids.

We are consistently testing and improving the products we provide, ensuring each child receives a custom device that will withstand the wear and tear of daily life and keep them on the move.

This year, to help our CoolKids move more comfortably, we improved the quality of our Joshi prosthetic knee joint by switching from local bushings to imported roller bearings in all aluminum joints.

This switch results in less friction with use, providing smoother movement and increases the joint's lifespan -- perfect for our CoolKids who are always on the move.





In 2021, we met Xeng.


In 2016, while riding his motorbike to school, a then 12 year old Xeng got in an accident, resulting in the amputation of his leg. His parents, a farmer and mechanic, could not afford the prosthesis Xeng needed to walk. Unable to stand, let alone walk to school, Xeng was distraught. He felt alone and had no hope for his future.

Five years later, we provided Xeng with his first prosthetic limb - our Joshi. Xeng, now 17 years old, is back in school with his sights confidently set on becoming a dentist. The ability to see yourself in whoever you want to be and to follow your dreams - whether it be a dentist or a rockstar - starts with the ability to move.

Hear it From Him. "Now I can go to school by myself and I can help my mother to do farming and feeding chicken. My family is very happy that I can do everything by myself... I can walk and move around very comfortable, I can play sport with my friend and I feel more confident." - Xeng

In 2021, we expanded our reach.

According to the World Health Organization, an estimated 70 million people worldwide need a wheelchair for basic mobility but as many as 95% of them do not have one, limiting their social inclusion and participation.

This year we began supplying COPE, our program partner in Laos, with World Health Organization certified, high-quality, appropriately fitted wheelchairs from various major manufactures around the world.

Since its creation in 1996, COPE's work has helped thousands of people with mobility-related disabilities, including UXO survivors, access prosthetic and orthotic services.

We are proud to restore mobility and dignity to children in need thanks to our newest program partnership with COPE, which will provide appropriatelyfitted wheelchairs to children throughout five provinces in Laos.



In 2021, we met Rakib.

A baby's first steps are supposed to be a joyous moment. When that day did not arrive as expected for Rakib, his parents were shocked and confused. They worried for their son's future and feared of a difficult life for Rakib, filled with isolation and judgment.

But one fateful day, a field worker from our program with Impact Foundation Bangladesh noticed Rakib crawling through a courtyard. They shared that Rakib's clubfoot could be corrected with the help of a pair of orthotic braces. Four year old Rakib now walks easily and plays with the neighborhood children. He has a bright future ahead of him filled with friends, family, school, and opportunity -- and without the struggle caused by neglected clubfoot.

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Hear it From Them. "I can recall that it was a Sunday morning; Rakib was crawling on the courtyard. An Apa, while passing through, came to me and asked about my son's foot. Then she told me that Rakib can get back his foot...that brought a great sense of happiness and relief....This is really the most enjoyable day of our life." - Rakib's Parents

Proudly investing in CoolKids around the globe.

After many years of investing in our mobility solutions for children in Cambodia, the **Arthur B. Schultz Foundation** once again approved a grant to support more CoolKids in need. This year, thanks to our mutual commitment to offering high-quality mobility solutions to children, we were able to commit these funds to providing appropriately fitted wheelchairs for three dozen of our patients, facilitated through our program partner Comprehensive Rehabilitation Services Uganda Hospital (CoRSU). We are grateful for their dedication to ensuring children everywhere have access to quality treatment and the transformative opportunities mobility brings.

Our inaugural partnership with the Tennessee-based **Jordan Thomas Foundation** (JTF) means nearly 50 more CoolKids received ALTSO's Joshi modular prosthetic limb kit in 2021. JTF is dedicated to ensuring children with limb disabilities all over the world continue to gain or regain their mobility, independence, and the opportunity to thrive. JTF has already matched its generous 2021 commitment to support Joshi treatments for CoolKids in need to kick off 2022, and we look forward to continuing this important partnership.
